


HAVE YOU EVER asked a friend to pray for you? Seeking their prayers brings comfort and a sense of support, especially during challenging times.

If our earthly friends' prayers provide comfort and grace, how much more powerful are the prayers of our heavenly friends—the Blessed Mother, saints, angels, and holy souls?

They, who are in God's presence, perfect and present our prayers to Him.

This illustrates our profound connection through God, forming the mystical Body of Christ and the Communion of Saints.





WHY USE INTERCESSORY PRAYER WITH YOUR FAMILY? When Father Peyton encouraged the world with his

realized vision that "THE FAMILY THAT PRAYS TOGETHER STAYS TOGETHER," and "A WORLD AT PRAYER IS A WORLD AT PEACE," he was zealous about it! He recognized the power of family prayer, especially the Rosary, in bringing healing and peace into the home and people's lives. Families today face many challenges, and our heavenly helpers, through intercessory prayer, can be an instrumental part of the solution. As we draw closer to God through prayer, we can help heal our families, communities, and the world.

Prayer doesn't need to follow a formula, but tools like the Rosary can help. Don't worry, because the beauty and grace of prayer, even if done imperfectly, is fully valid and effective. For example, if a child tries to help with a chore, but it's not done perfectly, it's the effort that matters. Of all the legacies we leave our children, none is more profound than teaching them how to pray and instilling it into their lives as a regular practice – for themselves, those they love, and those they may not know. Why? Because prayer is one of the most meaningful and powerful gifts we can give to another.

WAYS TO PRAY FOR INTERCESSION WITH YOUR FAMILY

- CREATE A PRAYER SPACE: Designate a space in your home where your family can gather for prayer. Decorate it, together, with a Bible, a cross, images of the Blessed Mother, or any of your favorite saints, and sacred items. Include a set of rosary beads for each member of your family.
- TAKE IT ONE STEP AT A TIME: Maybe praying together is a new concept for your family. Begin by instilling grace before meals. In time, add a morning prayer together to start the day, bless your children with the Sign of the Cross as they leave the house or before sleep. Pray just one decade of the Rosary (10 Hail Marys) together, first discussing the Mystery you've selected (discover helpful tips: familyrosary.org.) Include some prayers of intercession.





- INTERCEDE FOR OTHERS: Encourage your children to pray for the intercession of the saints. Engage their help and highlight a saint each week. Utilize the special prayer at the end of this booklet. Instilling a spirit of compassion and service will deepen your family's understanding and experience of the Communion of Saints through praying for their intercession together.
- ATTEND PILGRIMAGES AND RETREATS: Embark on pilgrimages to shrines or holy sites, such as the Father Peyton Center in Easton, Massachusetts.

Learn more: museumoffamilyprayer.org. Participate in retreats or workshops on the lives and teachings of the saints. These experiences offer opportunities for reflection, prayer, and renewal.

• MODEL YOUR FAITH THROUGH PRAYER: As parents, you are the most impactful source of faith in your children's lives. Talk about your faith with them. Cultivate their seeds of faith by showing them how to live the faith they have been given, striving to know, love, and serve God and others through your family life. Bear witness to the transformative power of faith and inspire your children to follow in the footsteps of the saints.

VENERABLE PATRICK PEYTON The mission of HOLY CROSS
